The successful applicant has a strong background in inorganic carbonate geochemistry and petrography (marine and/or continental carbonate archives). Successful applicants are expected to have a well assessed PhD in Geosciences (promotion data not more than 5 years ago) and documented teaching qualifications. The teaching load will be 4 hours per week in the first 3 years and 5 hours per week in year 4 to 6. Successful applicants will plan, organize and lead excursions and field camps on the B.Sc. and M.Sc. level. The ability to teach in English is expected. Non German-speaking applicants are expected to master German to a degree that they are able to teach in this language within 2 years. We expect that the successful applicant contributes to the academic administration of the faculty.

- readiness to participate in interdisciplinary academic work
- willingness and ability to attract external funding
- ability to perform fieldwork in remote and mountainous regions
